SCRATCH & HANDICAP MATCH-PLAY KNOCK-OUT COMPETITIONS

RULES

SCRATCH COMPETITION

A Match-play competition for members of A.L.C.G.A. who hold a 0-12 handicap before entry closing date.

1. Method of play shall be singles match-play, off scratch, over 18 holes.
2. In the event of the match being all square on the 18th green, sudden death format shall be played until the match reaches a conclusion.
3. The competition will be run on a 'Knock-out' format.
4. The County Captain and County Secretary shall make the draw.
5. The first player drawn shall have the advantage of playing the tie on her 'Home' course.
6. Players must nominate their 'home' course at point of entry.
7. It is the winner's responsibility to notify the County Secretary of the match result.
8. Ongoing results will be sent to participating clubs and will be on display at County monthly meetings.
9. All rounds of the competitions shall be played to pre-arranged deadline.
10. Green Fees involved shall be shared by both players.
11. Neither party is officially recognized as the challenger, therefore it is incumbent upon both parties to arrange the date and time for playing the match. If no result is recorded both names will be deleted.
12. County Secretary will arrange for the Final to be played over a neutral course.

HANDICAP COMPETITION (Junior Girls included)

A Match-play competition for all members of A.L.C.G.A who hold a Handicap before entry closing date.

1. Method of play shall be singles match-play off handicap (full difference) over 18 holes.
 2. In the event of the match being all square on the 18th green, **3 extra holes** shall be played, **then sudden death** until the match reaches a conclusion.
- 3 – 12 As above.

Members who hold handicaps 1-12 are eligible for both competitions
